FUND MANAGER'S REVIEW

BIMB-Arabesque Malaysia Shariah-ESG Equity Fund returned 0.31% for the month of July 2019. On a MoM basis the fund had outperformed its benchmark by 1.44% for SGD class Fund.

In the month of July 2019, the Fund had invested 69.54% of its NAV into Malaysian based equities. Most sectors contributed negatively due to weaker performance of its stock mix listed on Bursa Malaysia during the month. Performances from regional stocks were positive as the MSCI All World Index was up by 1.46% in the month of July in SGD terms. In terms of foreign country exposure, the Fund had invested 27.17% of its NAV in countries which includes USA 11.21%, UK 6.28%, Hong Kong 1.11%, Australia 1.79%, Switzerland 3.66% and EU 4.12%.

The Fund intends to invest up to 95% of its NAV into the equity market in every rebalancing exercise to stay invested in the market.

INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Fund seeks to achieve long-term capital appreciation.
Note: Medium to long-term in this context refers to 3 years or more.

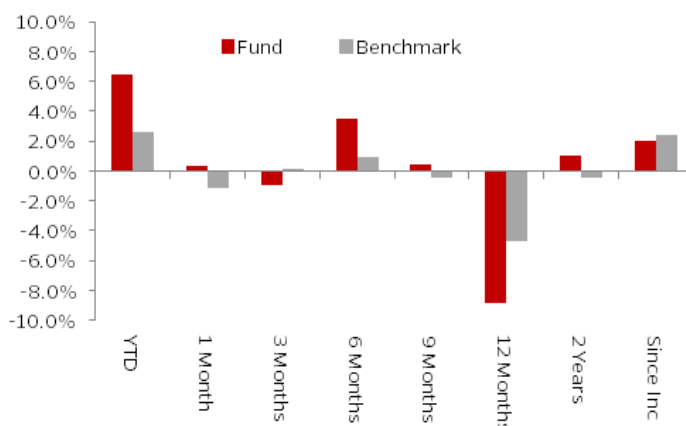

CUMULATIVE PERFORMANCE (%)

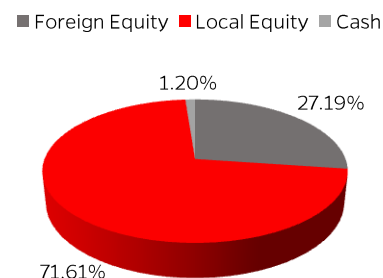
